Further, the reasoning for appointing counsel is not provided by the Deft., as we know there has not been a Habeas Corpus Petition filed, there does not appear to be a legal basis upon which he would need appointment of counsel, do understand he filed Motion for Modification of Sentence but again, we do not see any legal basis to allow that to proceed, there are procedural bars that he has been unable to overcome, does not see where appointment of counsel would change facts or circumstances. As to Motion to Modify Sentence which is also encompassed in the matter set on a future date, there is a procedural bar by the law of the case as well as Red Judicata, motion is also untimely, as the State has pointed out there is no conflict between the Amended Judgment of Conviction and the Habitual Criminal Notice contained in the Amended Information. Further, the arguments for modification of sentence are belied by the record, procedurally barred and ORDERED, motion DENIED. State to prepare order. There is also a Motion to Modify Sentence placed on calendar for July 19, 2021, and the Court does not have any reason to believe that is any different argument that has been set forth in the Motion to Appoint Counsel. COURT ORDERED, motion set for July 19, 2021, ADVANCED to today.

As to Motion to Stop Restitution, the Court is persuaded by the State's argument, primarily in the circumstances that he is not really entitled simply because two of the victims have passed away, to consider himself absolved of his restitution requirement and in the end, whether or not anyone has passed away, there is still possibility of their heirs being able to continue to receive and benefit from restitution. Further, from the State's argument there are still other victim's that need to be paid, no legal basis to support the arguments, Deft. did not provide any evidentiary basis for the claim the individuals have passed away and ORDERED, motion DENIED and restitution STANDS. Even if Deft. were to provide evidence two of the victims have passed away that would still not be a basis upon which to stop the order of restitution and the money is still legally able to be claimed and

entitled to be paid to the heirs of the individuals.

As to Motion to Appoint Counsel, COURT ORDERED, motion DENIED for the reasons primarily stated in the State's opposition. Further, the reasoning for appointing counsel is not provided by the Deft., as we know there has not been a Habeas Corpus Petition filed, there does not appear to be a legal basis upon which he would need appointment of counsel, do understand he filed Motion for Modification of Sentence but again, we do not see any legal basis to allow that to proceed, there are procedural bars that he has been unable to overcome, does not see where appointment of counsel would change facts or circumstances.

As to Motion to Modify Sentence which is also encompassed in the matter set on a future date, there is a procedural bar by the law of the case as well as Red Judicata, motion is also untimely, as the State has pointed out there is no conflict between the Amended Judgment of Conviction and the Habitual Criminal Notice contained in the Amended Information. Further, the arguments for modification of sentence are belied by the record, procedurally barred and ORDERED, motion DENIED.
