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

NON-MONETARY DEFAULT JUDGMENT AGAINST PACIFIC ALMADEN INVESTMENTS, LLC, AND COASTAL BENEFITS, LLC

Date of Hearing: November 10, 2021 Time of Hearing: 9:00 a.m.

This matter came before the Court on November 10, 2021, at 9:00 a.m. upon Plaintiff Alan T. Nahoum, Inc.'s ("<u>Plaintiff</u>") Application for Entry of Non-Monetary Default Judgment Against Pacific Almaden Investments, LLC, and Coastal Benefits, LLC (the "<u>Application</u>"). F. Thomas Edwards, Esq., of the law firm of Holley Driggs, appeared on behalf of Plaintiff and was accompanied by Alan Nahoum. No appearances were made on behalf of Defendants Pacific

Almaden Investments, LLC ("PAI") and Coastal Benefits ("Coastal"). Defendant Wylmina Hettinga appeared pro se.

The Court read and considered the Application. The record reflects proper notice to the parties in the action. No parties filed any oppositions to the Application. After being sworn in, the Court took the testimony of Mr. Nahoum.

Good cause appearing, the Court finds as follows:

- 1. Plaintiff and PAI are the sole members of Coastal.
- 2. The operating agreement of Coastal requires unanimous consent of the members to take any action on behalf of Coastal.
- 3. The relationship between Plaintiff and PAI, and its principal Hettinga, is irretrievably broken such that there is no possibility of reaching a consensus.
- 4. Given the deadlock between Plaintiff and PAI, it is not reasonably practicable to carry on the business of Coastal in conformity with the articles of organization or operating agreement.
 - 5. Therefore, judicial dissolution is appropriate pursuant to NRS 86.495.
- 6. Default was properly entered against Coastal on April 7, 2021, and PAI on April 8, 2021, for failure to appear.
- 7. Coastal and PAI, as entities, are not in the military service of the United States and are not an infant or incompetent person.

Good cause appearing, the Court orders as follows:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Plaintiff's Application for Non-Monetary Default Judgment Against PAI and Coastal is GRANTED in its entirety.
