

WHEREAS, on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2021, the Defendant entered a plea of guilty to the charge of TRANSPORTING A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, a Category C Felony, and the matter having been submitted before the Honorable Judge Michael R. Montero.

At the time Defendant entered the plea of guilty, this Court informed the Defendant of the privilege against compulsory self-incrimination, the right to a speedy trial, the right to a trial by jury, the right to compulsory process to compel witnesses to testify on behalf of the Defendant and the right to confront the accusers. That after being so advised, the Defendant stated that these rights were understood and still desired this Court to accept the plea of guilty.



#### SENTENCING HEARING

PRESENT: Anthony Gordon, Deputy District Attorney, present on behalf of the State. Marni Pool, present (via Zoom) on behalf of the Division of Parole and Probation. Defendant, present (in custody via Zoom), with counsel Matt Stermitz, Humboldt County Public Defender. Denni Byrd, Pre-Trial Services Coordinator, also present.

The record reflected that these matters come before the Court for sentencing. The Court asked if any party had an objection to these cases being heard together; no objections were heard. The Defendant had previously failed to appear at his sentencing hearing on May 18, 2021, and a bench warrant was issued and executed. The Court was in receipt of a Pre-Sentence Investigation Report, filed on April 15, 2021, as well as an Amended Pre-Sentence Investigation Report in CR2007199, filed on May 18, 2021; copies had been received and there were no factual corrections besides the need for additional credit for time served.

The Defendant had previously plead NO CONTEST to the charge of TRAFFICKING IN A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE-LEVEL II, a Category B Felony, in violation of NRS 453.3385(1)(b) in CR2007199, and GUILTY to the charge of TRANSPORTING A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, a Category C Felony, in violation of NRS 453.321(2)(A) in CR2007222. Copies of the Pre-Sentence Investigation Report had been received.

Gordon addressed the State's Supplemental Sentencing Memorandum, filed on November 10, 2021.

A discussion ensued regarding credit for time served. Pool informed the Court of an additional twentyone (21) additional days credit for time served on CR2007199 for a total of fifty-three (53) days and an additional twenty-one (21) days credit for time served on CR2007222 for a total of (117) days.

The Defendant exercised his right of allocution.

As to CR2007199, the Court pronounced the Defendant GUILTY of TRAFFICKING IN A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE-LEVEL II, a Category B Felony, and rendered judgment against the Defendant in the amount of \$3.00 DNA assessment fee, \$25.00 administrative assessment fee, \$60.00 forensic fee, \$150.00 DNA collection fee, and \$500.00 public defender fee. The Court further ordered that the Defendant serve a minimum term of seventy-two (72) and a maximum term of one hundred eighty (180) months in the Nevada Department of Corrections, with credit for time served in the amount of 53 days, and pay a \$100,000.00 fine.

As to CR2007222, the Court pronounced the Defendant GUILTY of TRANSPORTING A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, a Category C Felony, and rendered judgment against the Defendant in the amount of \$3.00 DNA assessment fee, \$25.00 administrative assessment fee, \$60.00 forensic fee, and a \$500.00 public

defender fee. The Court further ordered that the Defendant serve a minimum term of twenty-four (24) and a maximum term of sixty (60) months in the Nevada Department of Corrections, with credit for time served in the amount of one hundred seventeen (117) days. The Court ordered that the sentence imposed in CR2007222 shall run consecutive to the sentence imposed in CR2007199 The Defendant was remanded to the custody of the Sheriff to carry out his sentence.

The record reflected that these matters come before the Court for Arraignment Hearings.

The Court asked Stermitz if he and his client are ready to proceed to arraignment.

Stermitz stated that he does not believe that they can proceed with arraignment on both cases, the defendant is in possession of both plea agreements but only one has been signed and filed for case CR2007199, and the other has not been signed in case CR200722. Stermitz stated that his client does not agree with the plea agreement and expressed confusion over the signed and filed plea agreement.

Discussion ensued between the Court and counsel regarding the plea agreements.

The Defendant stated he understands the charges against him, but would like to inform the court that he has procured a new attorney and would motion the Court to continue these matters for two weeks.

The Court stated that today the Court, having no motion or order granted to withdraw Stermitz from these cases, the Court must proceed with arraignment and that the defendant is still represented by Stermitz. The Court asked if the Defendant is prepared to enter a plea.

The Defendant stated that he not prepared to enter a plea in either case.

The Court asked for a plea from the Defendant in case CR2007222.
