MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

I. DISCUSSION

NRAP 27(a)(1) states that "[a]n application for an order or other relief is made by motion unless these Rules prescribe another form." No rule in the NRAP provides for the confidential filing of portions of the appendix. NRAP 27(a)(2) then provides that any motion shall "state with particularity the grounds for the motion, the relief sought, and the legal argument necessary to support it."

Here, Appellant seeks to seal certain portions of her appendix that contain documents that were filed confidentially in the guardianship matter before the district court and documents that contain medical information. The documents that Appellant requests to seal are documents that are routinely filed confidentially before the district court as a matter of course with no litigation that takes place to seal these documents in the guardianship matter, or documents that contain medical information regarding Appellant. Appellant requests that this Court seal the following portions of Appellant's Appendix:

- AA00001–00006 (Confidential Physician's Certificate of Incapacity and Medical Records)
- AA00542–00549 (Confidential Report of AOC Investigator)

These documents were filed confidentially before the district court in the guardianship matter. AA0010–0006 contains sensitive medical information

regarding June's diagnosis, level of needs in regards to activities of daily living, 1 2 and details concerning her alleged "incapacity." AA0-00542-00549 is a report 3 from a court-appointed investigator that was filed confidentially with the district 4 court. June respectfully requests that these documents be sealed in this appeal 5 6 considering that they were filed confidentially before the district court and contain 7 sensitive medical information about June. 8 9 Simultaneous with the filing of this motion, Appellant will mail the abovementioned proposed sealed documents to the Supreme Court of Nevada

Clerk's Office.

V. <u>CONCLUSION</u>

Accordingly, this Court should grant Appellant's request to seal the abovementioned portions of Appellant's Appendix.
