

ORDER GRANTING MOTION

Petitioners have moved to stay issuance of the remittitur pending the filing of a petition for a writ of certiorari with the United States Supreme Court. Because this is an original writ petition, a notice in lieu of remittitur will issue instead of a remittitur. The motion is granted as follows. *Cf.* NRAP 41(b)(3). Issuance of the notice in lieu of remittitur shall be stayed until July 13, 2022. If the clerk of this court receives written notice by July 13, 2022, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that petitioners have filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, the stay shall continue in effect until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings. If such notice is not received by July 13, 2022, the notice in lieu of remittitur shall issue forthwith.

It is so ORDERED.
