

Further, the Court is not taking any argument as the Court did not request Deft. to be transported and this matter is able to be reviewed and assessed by the Court on the briefs alone to determine if there is any basis to set a future evidentiary hearing or otherwise possible entitlement to relief. The Court FINDS there is no entitlement to relief because the Writ of Prohibition is not the correct mechanism to be utilized in these circumstances. Further, the Court is not persuaded by the argument today and the more accurate information is what the State has provided in Opposition that there are in fact other mechanisms by which the Deft. would need to seek relief from the Nevada Department of Corrections. Either through administrative remedies that he may avail himself of or civil lawsuit that would allege some form of conversion or trespassed of property. Deft. also potentially could file a civil rights complaint under the 1983 action if he believes there is some action that is depriving him of a right or privilege that is protected by the Constitution or the law of the United States. The Court does not believe this Court has the authority and is too much of a stretch to say that this is a judicial function, now that Deft. is incarcerated in Nevada Department of Corrections, is engaging in their practices to take funds out to pay restitution that is somehow is something this Court would have jurisdiction to address on a Writ of Prohibition. The Court is declining for procedural reasons to treat this as a Writ of Prohibition properly filed and therefore,


