*O R D E R*

Appellants have filed a supplemental status report and motion to extend time to file the stipulation to dismiss appeal, informing this court that appellant, Giann Bianchi, has passed away. Upon the death of a party, an action may not proceed until a personal representative is substituted for the decedent. *Walker v. Burkham*, 68 Nev. 250, 253-54, 229 P.2d 158, 160 (1951). Accordingly, counsel for Giann Bianchi shall have 90 days from the date of this order to: (1) file a motion for the substitution of a personal representative or (2) inform this court that Giann Bianchi has no personal representative. See NRS 7.075(1); NRAP 43(a)(1); *Brass v. State*, 129 Nev. 527, 530, 306 P.3d 393, 394-95 (2013). We caution counsel for Giann Bianchi that failure to comply with this order may result in the dismissal of this appeal. See *Brass*, 129 Nev. at, 530, 306 P.3d at 394-95.

It is so ORDERED.<sup>1</sup>
