



Mr. Holmes's complaints appear to lack sufficient facts necessary to demonstrate the elements of Mr. Holmes's claims. Additionally, within the last three years, Mr. Holmes has filed five other complaints alleging intentional infliction of emotional distress, but each complaint was dismissed for failure to state a claim upon which relief could be granted. Likewise, Mr. Holmes's current complaints appear to lack any arguable factual or legal basis.

Therefore, the Court finds it is necessary that an Order to Show Cause Why Plaintiff Wilbert R. Holmes Should Not Be Deemed a Vexatious Litigant in one or more of the above referenced cases should issue. To accommodate this, Mr. Holmes's cases shall be coordinated through case no. A-17-760443-C and reassigned to Department 7 for the purpose of hearing the Order to Show Cause.

- Arguments by Mr. Fontano and Plaintiff, Wilbert Holmes. Court noted a Motion to Dismiss has a different standard than a Motion for Summary Judgment and further noted Plaintiff had not cited any points and authorities in his Opposition.
