*ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR SUMMARY ADJUDICATION*

This is an appeal from a January 6, 2022, district court order denying a pre-election challenge to the Better Voting Nevada initiative. Respondents have moved for summary adjudication, asking that this court resolve this appeal on the district court record, without further briefing, due to the purely legal issues it raises and the time-sensitive nature of its subject matter.
