21	FACTUAL AND PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND		
22	This is an appeal from the denial of a post-conviction petition for writ of habeas

25	804157-W. XVII:3741-43. The written judgment of conviction was filed on		
26	December 2, 2016, for the companion criminal case C-15-303991-1. XIII:3013-6.		
27	The trial court denied post-conviction relief initially orally at the hearing on the

briefings February 23, 2021. XVII:3628-82 at 3679-81. Jorge Mendoza was convicted of First-Degree Murder with use of a deadly weapon and 6 Felony B crimes after a 19-day jury trial which resulted, for him, in an aggregate sentence of 23 years to Life imprisonment on December 12, 2016, the Honorable Judge Carolyn Ellsworth presiding throughout. XIII:3013-6. The Opening Brief was filed August 4 2021. Respondent's Answering Brief was filed October 4, 2021. Appellant's Reply brief is currently due November 17, 2021. Due to the current caseload of this attorney, illnesses and hospitalization of 2 family members, and the upcoming holidays - Appellant would like additional time to ensure all of the 65 cases cited in the Answering brief can be carefully analyzed and addressed. Accordingly, counsel requests an additional sixty (60) days to file the Opening Brief or to Monday January 17, 2021.

GOOD CAUSE EXISTS TO ENLARGE THE TIME TO FILE APPELLANT'S OPENING BRIEF
