ORDER

Appellant is represented by attorney Jean J. Schwartzter in this appeal. On March 8, 2022, Ms. Schwartzter filed a motion for extension of time, until March 28, 2022, for appellant to file and serve a petition for rehearing or review. In her motion, Ms. Schwartzter indicated that she would be withdrawing as counsel of record for appellant. To date, Ms. Schwartzter has not moved to withdraw as appellant's counsel, and she remains counsel of record for appellant in this appeal.

On March 28, 2022, appellant filed a pro se motion for a second extension of time to file a petition for rehearing. As appellant is represented by counsel, he is not permitted to file documents, with the exception of a motion to remove counsel. See NRAP 46A(a). Accordingly, this court defers ruling on the motion. Ms. Schwartzter shall have 14 days from the date of this order to file a motion to withdraw as counsel of record, or appellant may file a motion to remove counsel within the same time period. Failure to comply with this order may result in rejection of appellant's pro se motion, see NRAP 46A(d), and the issuance of the remittitur.

It is so ORDERED.
