





ORDER DENYING MOTION

The court of appeals entered an order of affirmance on November 9, 2022. This court issued the remittitur on December 5, 2022. Appellant has filed a motion to recall the remittitur and for leave to file a petition for rehearing.

This court will recall the remittitur only when inadvertence, mistake of fact, or an incomplete knowledge of the circumstances of the case on the part of the court or its officers, whether induced by fraud or otherwise, has resulted in an unjust decision. *Wood v. State*, 60 Nev. 139, 141, 104 P.2d 187, 188 (1940). These factors are not applicable in this case. Accordingly, the motion is denied.
