



ORDER GRANTING MOTION AND STRIKING PETITIONS

Extraordinary and compelling circumstances having been shown, respondent/cross-appellant's motion for a second extension of time to file a petition for rehearing is granted. NRAP 26(b)(1)(B). However, this court is unable to accept the petition attached to the motion or the petition filed on May 24, 2022, because those documents do not have margins of at least 1 inch on all four sides and do not appear to be double-spaced as required by NRAP 32(a)(4). See NRAP 40(b)(1) (requiring petitions for rehearing to comply in form with NRAP 32). Because the petitions are not prepared in accordance with NRAP 32, the clerk shall strike the petition for rehearing attached to the May 24, 2022, motion and the petition for rehearing filed on that same date. See NRAP 32(e) ("If a . . . petition . . . is not prepared in accordance with this Rule, the clerk will not file the document, but shall return it to be properly prepared.").

Respondent/cross-appellant shall have 7 days from the date of this order to file and serve an amended petition for rehearing that complies with the formatting requirements of NRAP 32. If no amended petition for rehearing is filed, the clerk shall issue the remittitur.

It is so ORDERED.
