

In May, 2003, this Court denied his petition and he did not appeal the denial of his second petition. In January 2011, he filed a 3rd Petition for Writ; on December 19, 2011, the Nevada Supreme Court issued an Order affirming the dismissal of Defendant's petition on the merits.

This petition is time barred as Nevada Revised Statute imposes a one year time period for filing of a post-conviction petition for writ of habeas. We are clearly beyond that which would have been September 3, 2013.
