MEMORANDUM

Pursuant to NRAP 30(b)(6), "if a copy of appellant's presentence investigation report is necessary for the Supreme Court's review in a criminal case and a copy of the report cannot be included in the appendix, appellant shall file a motion with the clerk of the Supreme Court within the time period for filing an opening brief or fast track statement that the court direct the district court clerk to transmit the report to the clerk of the Supreme Court in a sealed envelope."

The presentence report is confidential and should not be made part of the public record pursuant to NRS 176.156. As such, a sealed copy should be transmitted to the Supreme Court by the district court clerk.

Here, the report is necessary because this is a sentencing-claims appeal and determination of whether any errors were prejudicial may turn on the reasonableness of the sentence, to include consideration of mitigating factors and Appellant's criminal record. Information relevant to those factors is found in the presentence report.
