*ORDER DIRECTING TRANSMISSION OF
SUPPLEMENTAL RECORD ON APPEAL*

This is a pro se appeal from the denial of a motion for modification of sentence. The record before this court does not contain a transcript of the district court hearings held on February 14, 2020, and February 26, 2020, in district court case number C-20-346867-1. A transcript of these hearings is necessary for this court's review of this appeal.

Accordingly, if the transcripts have been prepared and filed with the district court, the clerk of the district court shall transmit a certified copy to the clerk of this court within 10 days from the date of this order as a supplemental record on appeal. If the transcripts have not been prepared and filed below, court recorders Sharon Nichols (February 14, 2020, hearing) and Victoria Boyd (February 26, 2020, hearing) shall have 30 days from the date of this order to prepare and file the respective transcripts in the district court.¹ The clerk of the district court shall then

have 10 days from the date the transcripts are filed to transmit a certified copy to the clerk of this court as a supplemental record on appeal.
