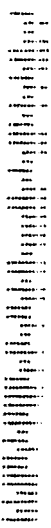

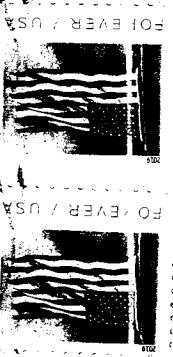

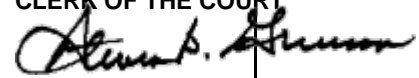

Neither counsel listened to the tape as to the second caller. They heard the first caller, Ms. Sandalin (phonetic). This is a violation of the confrontation clause to establish ineffective assistance of counsel. Ms. Weckerly stated there is no doubt defense did not hear the second part of the tape, but argued the Strickland case. Further arguments by counsel. COURT ORDERED, the

Court does not believe an Evidentiary Hearing is necessary, request DENIED. The factS are clear from a legal standpoint the Crawford case does apply. The Supreme Court determined in the case of City of North Las Vegas Vs. Walsh, the tape is not testimonial and does not trigger the confrontation clause. Whether counsel for deft listened to the tape, new about it or not, the fact will remain the person that made the second call will remain unidentified. Supreme Court ruled the 911 caller is not testimonial, is admissible and resgestae, therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, the Writ is DENIED. Ms. Weckerly to prepare the order and findings.



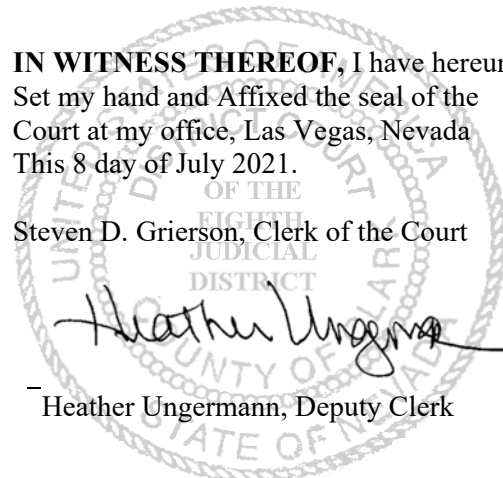
