ORDER DIRECTING TRANSMISSION OF SUPPLEMENTAL RECORD ON APPEAL

This is a pro se appeal from an order of the district court denying a motion to modify or correct an illegal sentence. The record before this court does not contain a transcript of the district court hearings held on August 6, 2019, and August 20, 2019, in district court case number C-16-314359-1. A transcript of these hearings is necessary for this court's review of this appeal.

Accordingly, if the transcripts have been prepared and filed with the district court, the clerk of the district court shall transmit certified copies to the clerk of this court within 10 days from the date of this order as supplemental records on appeal. If the transcripts have not been prepared and filed below, court recorders Norma Ramirez (for the August 6, 2019, hearing) and Patti Slattery (for the August 20, 2019, hearing) shall have 30 days from the date of this order to prepare and filed the transcripts in the district court.¹ The clerk of the district court shall then have 10 days from
