WHEREAS, on the 14th day of December, 2021, the Defendant entered his plea of no contest to the charge of DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE WITH TWO PRIOR CONVICTIONS WITHIN THE LAST SEVEN YEARS, a Category B Felony, and the matter having been submitted before the Honorable Judge Michael R. Montero.

At the time Defendant entered the plea of no contest, this Court informed the Defendant of the privilege against compulsory self-incrimination, the right to a speedy trial, the right to a trial by jury, the right to compulsory process to compel witnesses to testify on behalf of the Defendant and the right to confront the accusers. That after being so advised, the Defendant stated that these rights were understood and still desired this Court to accept the plea of guilty.

The Court having accepted the Defendant's plea of no contest, set the date of the 8th day of February, 2022, at the hour of 9:30 a.m. as the date and time for imposing judgment and sentence.

1 Furthermore, at the time Defendant entered the plea of no contest and at the time of
2 sentencing, Defendant was represented by attorney, MATT STERMITZ, Humboldt County
3 Public Defender,; also present in Court were TAMI RAE SPERO, Humboldt County Court Clerk
4 or her designated agent; MIKE ALLEN, Sheriff of Humboldt County or his designated agent;
5 ELIZABETH HILL and MARNI POOL, representing the Division of Parole and Probation; and
6 MICHAEL MACDONALD, Humboldt County District Attorney or his designated agent,
7 representing the State of Nevada.

8 The Defendant having appeared on 8th day of February, 2022, represented by counsel and
9 Defendant having been given the opportunity to exercise the right of allocution and having
10 shown no legal cause why judgment should not be pronounced at this time.

11 The above-entitled Court having pronounced LARRY JAY TOM guilty of DRIVING
12 UNDER THE INFLUENCE WITH TWO PRIOR CONVICTIONS WITHIN THE LAST
13 SEVEN YEARS, a Category B Felony, in violation of NRS 484C.110 and NRS 484C.400, on
14 the 8th day of February, 2022, the Defendant was thereby ordered by the Court to serve a
15 minimum term of twenty-four (24) months and a maximum term of seventy-two (72) months in
16 the Nevada Department of Corrections, with credit for time served of twenty-seven (27) days.

17 The Defendant is ordered to pay an administrative assessment fee in the amount of
18 \$25.00, a forensic fee in the amount of \$60.00, a DNA assessment fee in the amount of \$3.00
19 and a fine in the amount of \$2,000.00, payable to the Humboldt County Clerk of the Court.
20 Further, pursuant to NRS 176.0913, the Defendant is ordered submit a biological specimen under
21 the direction of the Nevada Department of Corrections to determine the Defendant's genetic
22 markers. Also, pursuant to NRS 176.0915, in addition to any other penalty, the Defendant must
23 pay a \$150.00 DNA fee, payable to the Humboldt County Clerk of the Court, and may not be
24 deducted from any other fines or fees imposed by the Court.

1 Further, pursuant to NRS 484C.460 prior to the reinstatement of the Defendant's driving
2 privileges, an interlock device shall be installed and inspected on his vehicle at his own expense
3 for a period of 12 to 36 months, said period to commence after any period of imprisonment,
4 residential confinement, confinement in a treatment facility, or on parole or probation and all
5 other applicable provisions of NRS 484C.340 and NRS 484C.460

6 Furthermore, bail, if any, is hereby exonerated.

7 MATT STERMIYZ, Humboldt County Public Defender, represented the Defendant
8 during all stages of the proceedings;

9 MICHAEL MACDONALD, Humboldt County District Attorney, represented the State
10 of Nevada at all stages of these proceedings.

ARRAIGNMENT

Anthony Gordon, Deputy District Attorney, present on behalf of the State. Elizabeth Hill and Marni Pool, present on behalf of the Division of Parole and Probation. Defendant, present with counsel Matt Stermitz, Humboldt County Public Defender. Denni Byrd, Pre-Trial Services Coordinator, also present.

The record reflected that this matter comes before the Court for an arraignment.

The Court explained the proceedings to the Defendant, who stated his understanding.

An Information, charging the crime of DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE WITH TWO PRIOR CONVICTIONS, a Category B Felony, in violation of NRS 484C.110 and NRS 484C.400 had been filed against the Defendant on October 25, 2021. The Defendant's true and correct name stated.

The Court interrogated the Defendant. A Preliminary Hearing had been waived. Copies of the Information had been received and counsel waived a formal reading. The Court stated the Defendant's Constitutional Rights. A Plea Agreement had been filed on October 27, 2021. The Court stated the essential elements the State would have to prove should this matter go to trial as well as the possible penalties.

The Defendant entered his plea of NO CONTEST.

The Court examined the Defendant and accepted his plea.

The Court ordered a Pre-Sentence Investigation Report be prepared and submitted to the Court prior to sentencing, which was set for February 8, 2022 at 9 a.m.

The record reflected that this matter comes before the Court for sentencing after the Defendant had previously pled NO CONTEST to the charge of DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE WITH TWO PRIOR CONVICTIONS WITHIN THE LAST SEVEN YEARS, a Category B Felony, in violation of NRS 484C.110 AND NRS 484C.400.

Copies of the Pre-Sentence Investigation Report had been received with one attachment, a handwritten letter from the Defendant. The Defendant had no factual correctios. The State had no factual correctios. The Court added the deputy district attorney name of Richard Haas to the report.

States Exhibit 1, criminal complaint filed 12/17/14, offered. States Exhibit 2, Forensic report, offered. States Exhibit 3, criminal complaint filed 3/26/14, offered. States Exhibit 4, Forensic report, offered. Stermitz objected to Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 3. Argument by Haas. Court reviewed Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 3 and found both to be valid. The Court admitted Exhibits 1,2,3, and 4.

Argument by Haas.

The Defendant exercised his right of allocution.

The Court pronounced the Defendant guilty of DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE WITH TWO PRIOR CONVICTIONS WITHIN THE LAST SEVEN YEARS, a category B felony, in violation of NRS 484C.110 and NRS 484C.400. The Court ordered the Defendant to pay an administrative assessment

fee of \$25.00, a \$3.00 DNA assessment fee, a \$60 forensic fee, a \$150.00 DNA fee, and a fine of \$2,000.00, payable to the Humboldt County Clerk of the Court. The Court then ordered the Defendant to serve a minimum term of twenty-four (24) months and a maximum term of seventy-two (72) months in the Nevada Department of Corrections, with credit for time served of twenty-seven (27) days. The Court lastly ordered the Defendant to be remanded into custody of the Humboldt County Sheriff and carryout the underlying sentence.
