## ORDER REGARDING COUNSEL AND GRANTING MOTION IN PART

Attorney Alexis E. Minichini of Nevada Defense Group has filed a notice of appearance as counsel for appellant. The clerk of this court shall add Ms. Minichini to the docket of this appeal as counsel of record for appellant.

Appellant has filed an unopposed motion for an extension of time to file his opening brief by 60 days. Applications for extensions of time beyond that to which the parties are permitted to stipulate under NRAP 31(b)(2) are not favored. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). The court will grant an initial motion for extension of time for filing a brief only upon a clear showing of good cause. *Id.* Appellant has not demonstrated that his request should be granted beyond the time to which the parties are permitted to stipulate, and the motion is therefore granted in part. Appellant shall have until July 28, 2022, to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. Failure to comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions. *See* NRAP 31(d).
