



ORDER

Petitioner filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus that did not include a proof of service; accordingly, on March 3, 2022, this court issued a notice directing petitioner to provide proof of service within 7 days. Petitioner failed to comply with the notice, and this court denied his petition for a writ of habeas corpus on March 24, 2022, in part based on this failure. On March 25, 2022, petitioner filed another petition with an attached note from a correctional officer informing this court that petitioner was unable to meet the 7-day deadline due to limitations within the prison. This new document appears to be petitioner's attempt to seek rehearing and to provide the proof of service. However, because the petition filed on March 25, 2022, is not identical to the original petition denied on March 24, 2022, the clerk of this court shall strike the petition filed on March 25, 2022, and shall file it as a new petition with a new docket number.

It is so ORDERED.
