ORDER DIRECTING WRITTEN ORDER AND EXPEDITED ANSWER

This emergency, original petition for a writ of mandamus and/or prohibition challenges a March 1, 2022, district court ruling denying petitioner's motion to disqualify the District Attorney's Office and to appoint a special prosecutor.

This court ordinarily will not consider a petition for extraordinary relief in the absence of a written district court order. See Rust v. Clark Cty. Sch. Dist., 103 Nev. 686, 689, 747 P.2d 1380, 1382 (1987) (providing that an oral pronouncement from the bench is not valid for any purpose). From the district court docket entries, it appears that a written order reflecting the challenged ruling was entered on March 7, 2022. Accordingly, petitioner shall have until noon tomorrow, March 9, 2022, to file and serve a supplemental appendix including a file-stamped copy of the district court's written order.
