ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

This is an appeal from a district court order granting respondent's motion to correct or modify sentence. Eighth Judicial District Court, Clark County; Erika D. Ballou, Judge.

On April 20, 2022, the district court entered an order vacating the February 2, 2022, order challenged in this appeal and transferring the matter to the First Judicial District Court. On June 8, 2022, this court entered an order directing the State to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. In response to the show-cause order, the State concedes that this appeal is premature. *See* NRS 177.015(3) (stating that appellant may appeal from a final judgment or verdict).
