



ORDER APPOINTING TASK FORCES

Pursuant to the Nevada Rules on the Administrative Docket, and in response to requests to review the current processes for the licensing of attorneys within Nevada, on March 9, 2022, this court created the Bar Licensing Commission (Commission) to study the issues and concerns arising from the methodology and administration of the bar examination and licensing procedures for attorneys within Nevada. In its report, filed on March 30, 2023, the Commission recommends the appointment of two task forces: (1) Foundational Subject Requirement and Performance Test Implementation Task Force and (2) Supervised Practice Task Force.

We agree with the Commission's recommendations and hereby appoint the Foundational Subject Requirement and Performance Test Implementation Task Force and the Supervised Practice Task Force. Further, the individuals listed in Exhibit A are appointed as members of the Foundational Subject Requirement and Performance Test Implementation Task Force. The individuals listed in Exhibit B are appointed to the Supervised Practice Task Force. Each Task Force shall file

a report with this court on their findings and recommendations no later than April 1, 2024.
