

*ORDER*

This is an appeal from a judgment of conviction. On March 24, 2022, this court was notified that attorney Monique A. McNeill was appointed as counsel for appellant. The clerk of this court shall remove the Clark County Public Defender's Office and add Ms. McNeill as counsel for appellant. Because appellant was not represented by Ms. McNeill in the district court proceedings, this appeal shall proceed as provided in NRAP 28, 28.2, 30, 31 and 32.

The briefing of this appeal shall proceed as follows. Appellant shall have 21 days from the date of this order to file the docketing statement and a file-stamped copy of the transcript request form. See NRAP 14; NRAP 9(a)(3). Appellant shall have 120 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and appendix. Thereafter, briefing shall proceed in accordance with the schedule set forth in NRAP 31(a)(1).
