*ORDER CONSOLIDATING APPEALS AND GRANTING, IN PART,
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME*

Appellant Robert G. Reynolds has filed a motion for an extension of time in both Docket Nos. 84000 and 84413, requesting a 120-day extension of time to file the opening brief and appendix in each appeal. He represents that this extension is necessary to allow time to file a motion to consolidate these appeals and a motion to correct a scrivener's error. Respondent has filed responses, arguing that such a lengthy extension of time is unnecessary.

These appeals arise from the same district court case and involve the same parties. This court concludes that in the interest of judicial economy, these appeals should be consolidated. Accordingly, these appeals shall be consolidated for all appellate purposes. *See* NRAP 3(b)(2).

The motion for an extension of time is granted to the following extent. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). Appellants shall have until August 29, 2022, to file a single opening brief and an appendix in these consolidated appeals. No further extensions of time shall be permitted absent demonstration of extraordinary circumstances and extreme need. *Id.* Counsel's caseload normally will not be deemed such a circumstance. *Cf. Varnum v. Grady*, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974). Failure to timely file the opening brief and appendix may result in the imposition of sanctions, including dismissal of these appeals. NRAP 31(d).

It is so ORDERED.
