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

16 decision for purposes of completing the decision. The case
17 wouldn't be mine anymore, but I've already talked the
18 presiding about, you know, what would happen if I just can't
19 get through everything and get it completely written before

21 minute order acknowledging that I still have this decision
22 under advisement, but the case is still assigned to either
23 department M, because that's who's taking over my case load,
24 or the random reassignment that it might happen because

1 there's going to be about 200 cases, 180 or so cases
2 reassigned away from my department and every other department
3 to the new judges. So -- so, you know, you could be one of
4 those because that's a 180 open cases. So with that, just
5 know that you could be shuffled somewhere else. You could
6 stay with what is my case load but you will ultimately end up
7 being reassigned to department M. But I just don't know which
8 one that'll be.

9 So like I said, my goal is to get it done before the
10 end of the year. I have one ahead of you that I'm almost
11 finished with and then it's you guys and then that's it. So
12 hopefully I can get it all accomplished.

13 MR. MAYO: Understand.

14 THE COURT: Okay. All right. Thanks, guys. I
15 appreciate it. I think that takes care of it. I wish David
16 and Christie the best and I'll get you guys a decision as soon
17 as I can.

18 MS. STUCKE: Thank you.

19 MR. MAYO: Thank you.

20 MR. PAGE: Thank you.

21 THE COURT: All right. Thanks, guys. Take care.

22 MR. PAGE: Take care.

23 THE COURT: Happy Holiday.

24 MR. PAGE: You too.
