PETITION

Ron D. Parraguirre, Chief Justice of the Nevada Supreme Court, petitions the Court, on its administrative docket, to consider the creation of a Committee to Study the Alternative Dispute Resolution Rules and Nevada Short Trial Rules. In support of the petition, Chief Justice Parraguirre alleges that:

1. The Rules Governing Alternative Dispute Resolution and Nevada Short Trial Rules are essential to the fair and efficient administration of justice in Nevada.

2. The Nevada Supreme Court adopted the Rules Governing Alternative Dispute Resolution and Nevada Short Trial Rules on December 22, 2004; the Rules took effect January 1, 2005.


3. Since their adoption, the Rules Governing Alternative Dispute Resolution and Nevada Short Trial Rules have been periodically amended; however, it is now time for the Nevada Supreme Court to review and consider recommendations for comprehensive amendments to the Rules, as applicable.

Accordingly, petitioner requests that the Nevada Supreme Court place this matter on its administrative docket, hold such hearings as it deems necessary and approve the creation of the Committee to Study the
