### POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

NRAP 41(b)(2) provides for a stay of the issuance of this Court's remittitur pending the filing of a petition for certiorari in the United States Supreme Court. See NRAP 41(b)(2). "A party may file a motion to stay the remittitur pending application to the Supreme Court of the United States for a Writ of certiorari." Id. The rule contemplates a stay of 120 days unless good cause is shown. Id.

This Motion originally filed was denied on March 22, 2024, as being untimely / early, as the Petition for Review was pending. See NSC Order attached hereto. Appellant received notice of his Petition being denied at 11:18 am on March 25, 2024. Appellant checked the NSC website at 11:19 am and noticed the Remittitur had already been filed.
