



*ORDER RECALLING AND STAYING THE REMITTITUR*

On March 25, 2024, this court entered an order denying appellant's petition for review, the remittitur issued in the normal course, and appellant filed a motion for stay of the remittitur pending application for a writ of certiorari in the United States Supreme Court. *See* NRAP 41.

This court construes appellant's motion to stay the remittitur as a motion to recall and stay the remittitur. Cause appearing, appellant's motion is granted. *See* NRAP 41(b)(3). The clerk of this court shall recall the remittitur issued on March 25, 2024, and reinstate this appeal. Issuance of the remittitur is hereby stayed until July 23, 2024. If the clerk of this court receives written notice by July 23, 2024, from the clerk of the United States Supreme Court that appellant has filed a petition for a writ of certiorari, the stay shall continue in effect until final disposition of the certiorari proceedings. If such notice is not received by July 23, 2024, the remittitur shall issue forthwith.

It is so ORDERED.
