POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

FACTUAL BACKGROUND

On July 13, 2021, a Case Appeal Statement was filed. On that same date a rejection was filed for the Statement being late as it was to be filed on July 12, 2021. On July 12, 2021 Counsel had several hearings that lasted until late in the day.
