



LETTER TO AARON D. FORD, NEVADA ATTORNEY GENERAL

Attn: Aaron D. Ford, Nevada Attorney General:

This is a request for verification as this alleged debt is in dispute. I am not refusing to pay a debt which I lawfully owe, but I need verification of the debt before we can proceed. Please answer the following questions relating to the disputed account and return them to me within thirty (30) days, with your Affidavit which validates the answers. 5 phone call, so if you write or call again, absent the proof
6 required below, it will comprise your contractual agreement to
7 pay my consultation fees.

9 address of the person answering the following questions.

10 • Please furnish a copy of the contract which The
11 Office of the Clark County District Attorney Family Support
12 Division (DAFS) has with SILVER, FREDERICK OMOYUMA in
13 regards to this alleged Debt in CASE NO: R-17-196685-R UPI-

15 • Please identify what you loaned to SILVER,
16 FREDERICK OMOYUMA. Did you loan SILVER, FREDERICK OMOYUMA
