
ORDER DISHONORABLY DISCHARGING PROBATIONER

This Court previously placed the Defendant named in the caption on probation. The Division of Parole and Probation has filed a Petition requesting the discharge of the Defendant from probation in this case.

- This Court finds that the Defendant successfully completed probation. As a result, the Court orders the honorable discharge of the Defendant from probation.
