Myrtis was not seen driving the vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, the claim was actual physical control.

The officers unlawfully stopped and detained Myrtis without reasonable suspicion of criminal activity.

The court refused to instruct the jury on Nevada law regarding conflicting circumstantial evidence.

The court refused to allow counsel to argue applicable Nevada law regarding conflicting circumstantial evidence.

Nevada law creates confusing "guideposts" for jury deliberations respecting "actual physical control of an automobile" without informing juries of the burden of proof in determining the applicability of any single factor, or multiple factors that have not been proved during the trial.
