LANDOWNERS' MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE COMBINED ANSWERING BRIEF [84345] AND OPENING BRIEF [84640] (Second Request)

Landowners respectfully move this Court, pursuant to NRAP 31(b) for an extension of 30 days in which to file their combined answering brief in Docket No. 84345 and opening brief in Docket No. 84640.

On September 7, 2022, the Court entered an order granting the stipulation of the parties modifying the briefing schedule, which set October 17, 2022 as the deadline for the City's opening brief based upon the City's request for a second extension of time.
