



ORDER CORRECTING OPINION


This court recently issued an opinion in this appeal: *In re Guardianship of Jones*, 139 Nev., Adv. Op. 57, ___ P.3d ___ (December 21, 2023). The opinion contains typographical errors in the subheading on page 15 and in the conclusion section on page 16. In particular, "Brookfield" should read "Brickfield." The clerk of this court is directed to correct, in the advance opinion, the subheading to read "*The award of Brickfield's fees at a rate of \$400 per hour is reasonable*" and the two pertinent sentences in the conclusion to read as follows: "Although the district court erred by failing to include Brickfield's rate in the order of appointment, June waived this argument by failing to raise it below. . . . Finally, while Brickfield is a fiduciary entitled to fiduciary fees, the district court did not abuse its discretion in awarding her fees in an amount commensurate with her

attorney rate because the award was supported by the GAL's experience, specialized knowledge, and ability to understand the intricacies of this particular case's complex legal issues."

It is so ORDERED.
