

ORDER GRANTING MOTION

This is an appeal from an order and injunction invalidating a ballot petition. The parties have filed a stipulation to expedite the briefing schedule. The stipulation is not signed by counsel of record for all parties.¹ Accordingly, the stipulation is treated as a joint motion and granted. Appellant shall have until July 8, 2022, to file and serve the opening brief. Respondents shall have until July 18, 2022, to file and serve the answering brief. Appellant's reply brief shall be due on July 25, 2022.
