SENTENCED as to COUNT 1 to a MINIMUM of FORTY-EIGHT (48) MONTHS and a MAXIMUM of TWO HUNDRED FORTY (240) MONTHS in the Nevada Department of Corrections (NDC) and COUNT 2 - a MINIMUM of FORTY-EIGHT (48) MONTHS and a MAXIMUM of TWO HUNDRED FORTY (240) MONTHS in the Nevada Department of Corrections (NDC) to run CONCURRENT with COUNT 1, with SIX HUNDRED and SIX (606) DAYS credit for time served.

COURT FURTHER ORDERED, a special SENTENCE OF LIFETIME SUPERVISION is imposed to commence upon release from any term of probation, parole or imprisonment and Deft. is to register

as a sex offender in accordance with NRS 179D.460 within 48 hours after sentencing.
