MOTION REQUESTING TRANSMITTAL AND FILING OF EXHIBITS UNDER SEAL

COMES NOW Petitioner, Keandre Valentine, by and through his attorney, SHARON G. DICKINSON, Chief Deputy Public Defender, and pursuant to NRAP 28, 30(d),10(b)(1) asks this Court to direct the District Court to send exhibits <u>under seal</u> to this Court. Keandre asks that the District Court send, under seal, Court Exhibits 1 and 2, that were entered into evidence, under seal, at the 05/03/22 hearing. Keandre seeks this order to allow the Court to use these Court Exhibits in reaching a decision on the issues presented in his Petition filed 05/26/22. Keandre further asks that Court Exhibits 1 and 2 remain and be filed under seal in the Nevada Supreme Court until the case is closed. This Motion is based upon the following Memorandum and all papers and pleadings on file herein.

MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

Court's Exhibits 1 and 2, which were filed with the Eighth Judicial District Court, Department VI, on 05/03/22, are a subset of the electronic unredacted version of the jury commissioner's master list, dated January 2020. In February of 2021, the Defense signed an agreement with the jury commissioner, which was approved by the district court, to obtain access to the electronic version of the master list. In the agreement, the Defense agreed to take steps to keep all the master list information confidential and for it to be placed under seal. *See Exhibit A*. The reason for keeping the information sealed is because the jury master list contains information on all prospective jurors that the jury commissioner may summon for jury duty in Clark County, Nevada. Thus, to protect the privacy of the documents and all prospective jurors, we agreed to keep the information under seal.

Likewise, the prosecutor agreed to keep all information regarding the jury master list under seal. *Exhibit A*. Accordingly, the State is precluded from objecting to this motion requesting Court Exhibits 1 and 2 be maintained under seal in this Court.

Contrary to our agreement, in *Howard v. State*, 128 Nev. Adv. Op. No. 67, 291 P.3d 137 (2012), this Court held that there is a <u>presumption in</u> <u>favor of allowing the public access to all documents</u> filed within the Nevada Supreme Court. *Id.* at 142. In accord with this reasoning, the *Howard* Court held that all documents "filed in this court are presumptively open to the public unless we exercise our inherent authority and grant a motion to file specific documents under seal based on a showing that such action is required by law or an identified significant competing interest." *Id.* at 139.

The *Howard* sealing rules require this Court to decide if the documents or exhibits will be sealed. The reason for the sealing of these exhibits is as follows:

- The Court Exhibits Keandre is attempting to seal with the Nevada Supreme Court are confidential jury information as to all prospective jurors in Clark County who were on the jury master list for the Eighth Judicial District Court at the time of Keandre's trial. The information on these Court Exhibits is massive since the original jury master list contained millions of names and information on prospective jurors. One of the Court Exhibits also contains a list of duplicate information.
- 2. The reason the sealing is necessary is because the Eighth Judicial District Court and the jury commissioner gave Keandre and the prosecutor access to this confidential information based on an agreement to keep the information forever under seal. The agreement

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is in place for several reasons, to include for the protection of the privacy of the prospective jurors. Thus, the order requires the sealing of these documents.

3. The duration for our request for an Order Sealing the Court Exhibits is that the sealing should remain forever or until the Court closes the case and sends the Court Exhibits back to the Eighth Judicial District Court Evidence Vault under seal.

Accordingly, Keandre asks this Court to issue an order sealing Court Exhibit 1 and 2 which were sealed in Keandre's case on 05/03/22.

As for as transmitting the Court Exhibits, NRAP 30(d) allows a Petitioner to include copies of relevant and necessary exhibits in the appendix. However, if an exhibit is not able to be reproduced, a party may:

>file a motion requesting the Supreme Court to direct the district court clerk to transmit the original exhibits. The Supreme Court will not permit the transmittal of original exhibits except upon a showing that the exhibits are relevant to the issues raised on appeal, and that the Supreme Court's review of the original exhibits is necessary to the determination of the issue.

NRAP 30(d).

Defendant asks that this Court to direct the District Court Clerk's office to transmit Court Exhibits 1 and 2 under seal to this Court where they will remain under seal based on the reasons listed previously. These Court

Exhibits were entered <u>under seal</u> at the hearing held on 05/03/22, in the Eighth Judicial District Court, Department VI. II:280. These exhibits are CD/DVD exhibits that may not be reproduced and placed inside an appendix. The court exhibits are needed if the Court intends to review and make a decision on Keandre's Petition for a Writ of Mandamus or alternately for a Writ of Prohibition. The Court Exhibits are part of the focus of the Petition.
