JUDGMENT OF CONVICTION

On the 9th day of November, 2021, the above-named Defendant, SHAWN TOSH HARTZELL, Date of Birth: November 15, 1971, Place of Birth: Martinez, California, entered a plea of no contest pursuant to *North Carolina v. Alford.* 400 US 25 (1970) to the crime(s) of: COUNT 1, Abuse, Neglect Or Endangerment Of A Child, a Category B Felony, in violation of NRS 200.508(1)(B)(1), and COUNT 2, Lewdness With A Child Under Age 14, a Category A Felony, in violation of NRS 201.230(1)(a) and 201.230(2).

Further, that at the time the Defendant entered the plea of no contest pursuant to *North Carolina v. Alford* 400 U.S. 25 (1970), this Court informed the Defendant of the privilege against compulsory self-incrimination, the right to a speedy trial, the right to a trial by jury, the right to compulsory process to compel witnesses to testify on behalf of the Defendant, and the right to confront the accusers. That after being so advised, the Defendant stated that these rights were understood and still desired this Court to accept the plea of no contest pursuant to *North Carolina v. Alford* 400 U.S. 25 (1970).

Further, that at the time the Defendant entered a plea of no contest pursuant to *North Carolina v. Alford* 400 U.S. 25 (1970), and at the time of sentencing, the Defendant was

represented by an attorney, STEVE E. EVENSON, or the duly appointed representative; also present in Court were the Churchill Court Clerk, or the duly appointed representative, the Sheriff of Churchill County, or the duly appointed representative, the District Attorney of Churchill County, Nevada, or the duly appointed representative, representing the State of Nevada; and the Operations Supervisor, or the duly appointed representative, representing the Division of Parole and Probation.

The Court having accepted the Defendant's plea of no contest pursuant to *North* Carolina v. Alford 400 U.S. 25 (1970), and having set the date of April 5, 2022, as the date for imposing judgment and sentence and the Defendant having appeared at such time, represented by counsel, and the Defendant having been given the opportunity to exercise the right of allocution, and having shown no legal cause why judgment should not be pronounced at that time.

This Court thereupon pronounced SHAWN TOSH HARTZELL guilty of: COUNT 1, Abuse, Neglect Or Endangerment Of A Child, a Category B Felony, in violation of NRS 200.508(1)(B)(1), and COUNT 2, Lewdness With A Child Under Age 14, a Category A Felony, in violation of NRS 201.230(1)(a) and 201.230(2).

In accordance with the applicable statutes of the State of Nevada this Court sentenced the Defendant to:

ON COUNT 1: imprisonment in the Nevada State Prison for a minimum term of 24 months, with a maximum term of 60 months, and a minimum parole eligibility of 24 months; and

ON COUNT 2: imprisonment in the Nevada State Prison for a minimum term of 10 years, and a maximum term of life, and a minimum parole eligibility of 10 years, consecutive to Count 1.

The Defendant is given credit for 381 days of pre-sentence incarceration time served. In addition, said Defendant shall pay:

 An Administrative Assessment Fee in the amount of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) to Tenth Judicial District Court.

- A DNA Fee in the amount of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) to Tenth Judicial District Court.
- A Genetic Marker Analysis Fee in the amount of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to Tenth Judicial District Court.

Pursuant to NRS 176.0913, Defendant must submit a biological specimen to determine genetic markers and/or secretor status.

Pursuant to NRS 176.035(2) Count 1 and Count 2 of this case are hereby aggregated to imprisonment in the Nevada State prison for a minimum term of 144 months to a maximum term of life imprisonment.

Pursuant to NRS 176.0931, the Defendant is subject to lifetime supervision.

Pursuant to NRS 179D.460, the Defendant must register as a Sex Offender.

Therefore, the Clerk of the above-entitled Court is hereby directed to enter the Judgment of Conviction as a part of the record in the above-entitled matter.
