## ORDER CONDITIONALLY IMPOSING SANCTIONS

On September 14, 2021, this court entered an order denying appellant's motion for an extension of time and directing appellant to serve and file, in this court, a file-stamped transcript request form in compliance with NRAP 9(a) and the opening brief and appendix within 7 days. This court cautioned that failure to timely comply could result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this appeal. NRAP 9(a)(7); NRAP 31(d). Appellant filed the opening brief and appendix on September 21, 2021. However, those documents were rejected by the clerk of this court on that same date because they were not signed by counsel of record. See NRAP 25(a)(5). The clerk directed appellant to re-file the documents and a notice of appearance within 5 days. On September 22, 2021, counsel filed a notice of appearance. However, counsel did not re-file the opening brief and appendix, file the transcript request form, or otherwise communicate with this court regarding these documents. Accordingly, on November 2, 2021, this court entered an order directing appellant to serve and file, in this

court, a file-stamped transcript request form in compliance with NRAP 9(a), and the opening brief and appendix.<sup>3</sup> This court again cautioned that failure to timely comply could result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of this appeal. On November 9, 2021, appellant refiled the opening brief and appendix. That same date, the clerk of this court rejected the opening brief because it did not comply with the pagenumbering requirements of NRAP 32(a)(4).<sup>4</sup> The clerk directed appellant to correct the deficiencies and re-file the brief within 5 days. On November 15, 2021, appellant re-filed the opening brief. The clerk again rejected the brief because it contained the same deficiency with respect to pagenumbering.<sup>5</sup> The clerk directed appellant to correct the deficiency and refile the opening brief within 5 days. To date, appellant has not re-filed the opening brief, filed the transcript request form, or otherwise communicated with this court.

The failure of appellant's counsel, Danielle A. Kolkoski, Thomas A. Larmore, Robert L. Thompson, and Ryan M. Venci to file the transcript request form and opening brief in compliance with this court's procedural rules, the notices issued in this matter, and the orders entered herein warrants the *conditional* imposition of sanctions. Accordingly, counsel for appellant shall, within 14 days from the date of this order, pay the sum of \$500 to the Supreme Court Law Library and provide this court with proof of such payment. These sanctions shall be automatically vacated if appellant timely files and serves the transcript request form or,

alternatively, a certificate that no transcripts will be requested, see NRAP 9(a)(1)(C), (a)(3), and a procedurally compliant opening brief. Failure to comply with this order may result in the imposition of additional sanctions, including the referral of counsel to the State Bar of Nevada and the dismissal of this appeal. See NRAP 9(a)(7); NRAP 31(d)(1).

It is so ORDERED.
