



ORDER DISMISSING APPEAL

Michael Todd Botelho appeals from an order of the district court denying a motion for the appointment of counsel filed on April 21, 2020, an affidavit and criminal complaint filed on March 12, 2021, and a judicial notice and criminal complaint filed on April 2, 2021. Second Judicial District Court, Washoe County; Kathleen M. Drakulich, Judge.

Because no statute or court rule permits an appeal from the aforementioned order, we lack jurisdiction. *See Castillo v. State*, 106 Nev. 349, 352, 792 P.2d 1133, 1135 (1990). Accordingly, we
