

He discovered that belief was wrong when he filed a notice of appeal on October 29 2018, which the Supreme Court of Nevada dismissed as untimely. At the evidentiary hearing, Shana Brouwers, second chair at the trial, testified that anytime a guilty verdict comes back subsequent to a jury trial it is the Public Defenders Office's policy to send the file to the appellate team for review. It is also the Office's policy to send the file for review regardless of whether the defendant requests counsel to pursue an appeal. Ms. Brouwers further testified that lead trial counsel never sent the file to the appellate team for review. Ultimately, Ms. Brouwers admitted that lead trial counsel failing to file a notice of appeal was ineffective.

Petitioner was clearly deprived of his right to appeal. Accordingly, the Court finds that there is good cause for Petitioner's delay in filing his notice of appeal.
