ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS

Verbatim Reporting & Transcription (VRT) has filed a motion for an extension of time to prepare transcripts requested in this appeal. Cause appearing, the motion is granted to the following extent. See NRAP 3E(f)(3). VRT shall have until January 10, 2022, to file the requested transcripts in the district court and to deliver copies to the requesting party. See NRAP 3E(c)(2)(C). VRT shall, within the same time period, file a notice with this court that the completed transcripts have been filed and delivered. Id. Failure to comply with this order may result in the imposition of sanctions. NRAP 3E(i).

Appellant's motion for a second extension of time to file the fast track statement is granted. Appellant shall have until February 7, 2022, to file and serve the fast track statement and appendix. NRAP 31(b)(3)(B). No further extensions shall be permitted absent demonstration of extreme need or merit. NRAP 3E(f)(3). Counsel's caseload normally will not be deemed such a circumstance. *Cf. Varnum v. Grady*, 90 Nev. 374, 528 P.2d 1027 (1974). Failure to timely file the fast track statement and appendix may result in the imposition of sanctions, including the dismissal of the appeal. NRAP 3E(i).
