POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

On March 4, 2022, the Nevada Supreme Court granted Appellant's fourth request for an extension of time to file his fast track statement and appendix and further ordered that Respondent file her fast track response would therefore be due on or before March 24, 2022.

This office inadvertently calendared the due date of Respondent's fast track response for April 24, 2022 instead of March 24, 2022 and just realized the error on April 1, 2022. This office immediately contacted the Nevada Supreme Court and asked for a two week extension to file Respondent's fast track response but since the March 24, 2022 due date had already passed, the extension request via telecommunications was denied and this office was directed to file a motion requesting an extension to file Respondent's fast track response.

The Nevada Supreme Court has the authority to grant Respondent an extension of time to file her fast track response pursuant to NRAP 3E(f)(3) if extreme need or merit is demonstrated. Here, this office inadvertently calendared the due date of Respondent's fast track response for April 24, 2022 instead of March 24, 2022 and this office did

not discover the error until April 1, 2022. Obviously with the due date having passed, there is no ability for this office to file Respondent's fast track response in a timely fashion.

The undersigned asks that an extension of time be granted to file Respondent's fast track response on or before April 18, 2022. This is Respondent's first request for an extension of time to file her fast track response while Appellant was granted four extensions to file his fast track statement.

CONCLUSION

Based upon the foregoing, Respondent, Nadine Williams, respectfully requests that this Court grant her request for an extension of time to file her fast track response and that the same be due on or before April 18, 2022.
