Petition For Writ of Mandamus

or in the Alternative Show Cause

Comes Now, petitioner, Travis Bowles, in proper and requests this Honorable Court to consider this petition for writ of Mandamus or in the alternative Show Cause, this petition is made under color of NRS 34.160 through and inclusive of NRS 34.310.

Petitioner relies on the following authorities:

NRS 34.160 which states in pertinent part "The writ may be issued by the Supreme Court, the Court of Appeals... to compel the performance of an act which the law especially enjoins as a duty resulting from an office, trust or station."

Where no discretion is given to an officer or body, Mandamus lies to enforce a performance of the specific act required. Douglas G. Bol of Carmines v. Peterson, 78 Nev 126, 369 P.2d 669.

369 P.2d 669

This case is closely associated with the case, Travis Bowles v. Judge Connie Steinheimer, Second Judicial District Court. A Mandamus also filed in this Court, petitioner requests appropriately that this Court hear and decide this mandamus.

Request for Relief

This petition for writ of Mandamus is sought to compel the Nevada Department of Corrections, Offender Management Division to return petitioner and all his possessions, in the most appropriate manner, to Northern Nevada Correctional Center until such time as he receives a full and fair Evidentiary Hearing on the merits of his petition, as he was erroneously transferred off of the NNCC yard without the holding of an Evidentiary Hearing on his writ of Habeas Corpus as required by NRS 34.770(1) in pertinent part "... A petitioner must not be discharged or committed to the custody of a person other than the respondent unless an evidentiary hearing is held.

The Respondent in petitioner's writ of Habeas Corpus was Isidro Baca, Warden, NNCC and becomes whomever assumes that position.

No Evidentiary Hearing was held as required.

NRS 34.830(2) "A copy of any decision or order committing the petitioner to the custody of another person... must be served upon the Respondent..."

petitioner requests that the NDOC, OMD produce the above "decision or order" if it is in possession of such "decision or order" and they provide a copy of said "order or decision" to this court and to the petitioner as he never received one.

In July of 2021 petitioner was moved from NNSCT to Warm Springs Correctional Center without notice, NNSC retained one box of legal materials, which to date has not been returned to petitioner, In August of 2021 petitioner was moved to Lakeview Correctional Center for his own safety.

petitioner requests the granting of this writ or in the alternative, that the Nevada Department of Corrections show cause as to why it should not issue.

petitioner prays this court find the defendant at fault and grant his writ of Mandamus and compel the specified performance as required by law.
