

*ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO TRANSMIT PRESENTENCE  
INVESTIGATION REPORT*

The motion to direct the district court clerk to transmit a copy of the presentence investigation report in this matter (district court case number DC-CR-21-90) is granted. NRAP 30(b)(6). The district court clerk shall have 14 days from the date of this order to transmit to the clerk of this court a copy of the presentence investigation report in a sealed envelope. *See id.*; NRS 176.156(5) (providing that except for specific disclosures authorized by NRS 176.156(1)-(4), a presentence investigation report is “confidential and must not be made a part of any public record”).

It is so ORDERED.
