ORDER REINSTATING BRIEFING

This is an appeal from an order granting summary judgment. On October 19, 2022, this court entered an order directing appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. This court noted that it appeared the district court had not entered a final written judgment adjudicating all the rights and liabilities of all the parties, and the district court had not properly certified its order as final pursuant to NRCP 54(b). Lee v. GNLV Corp., 116 Nev. 424, 996 P.2d 416 (2000); KDI Sylvan Pools v. Workman, 107 Nev. 340, 810 P.2d 1217 (1991); Rae v. All American Life & Gas. Co., 95 Nev. 920, 605 P.2d 196 (1979). Appellant has filed a response to which it attaches a copy of the district court's order finding no just reason for delay and certifying the order as final. See Aldabe v. Evans, 83 Nev. 135, 425 P.2d 598 (1967). This appeal may proceed.

The deadlines for filing documents are reinstated as follows. Appellant shall have 14 days from the date of this order to file and serve a transcript request form or certificate that no transcript is to be requested. See NRAP 9(a). Appellant shall have 90 days from the date of this order to file and serve the opening brief and appendix.

It is so ORDERED.
