13 enter by Eighth Judicial District Court Judge, JASMIN LILLY-SPELLS, titled: (1) ORDER FOR
SUMMARY PUNISHMENT OF CONTEMPT COMMITTED IN THE IMMEDIATE VIEW AND PRESENCE
14 OF THE COURT, Exhibit 1, (2) ORDER TO APPEAR IN PERSON, Exhibit 2; notice to transfer;
notice of hearing; dismissal with prejudice; notice of asbestos claim and remedy.

15 **APPEAL**

16 The order entered by Eighth Judicial District Court Judge, JASMIN LILLY-SPELLS, titled
ORDER FOR SUMMARY PUNISHMENT OF CONTEMPT COMMITTED IN THE IMMEDIATE VIEW AND
17 PRESENCE OF THE COURT, Exhibit 1, assigns the habeas corpus hearing not in the same
department where the underlying criminal case is filed. Therefore being in direct
18 contravention of Nev. R. Cr. P. Rule 9, section 6, "Any writ filed in a criminal case at the
district court level shall be assigned to the same department where the underlying
19 criminal case is filed." Thus being null and void pursuant to WILLIAMSON v. BERRY, "Courts
are constituted by authority and they cannot go beyond that power delegated to them. If
20 they act beyond that authority, and certainly in contravention of it, their judgments and
orders are regarded as nullities; they are not voidable, but simply void, and this even prior
to reversal." 8 HOW. 945, 540 12 L. Ed. 1170, 1189 (1850).

21
22 The order entered by Eighth Judicial District Court Judge, JASMIN LILLY-SPELLS, titled
ORDER TO APPEAR IN PERSON, Exhibit 2, orders the Defendant to "APPEAR IN PERSON" in
Department 23 for an Habeas Corpus Hearing, without the Defendant's written consent.
23 Therefore, being in direct contravention of Nev. R. Cr. P. Rule 9, SECTIONS 6. Thus,
rendering the order null and void pursuant to WILLIAMSON V. BERRY, 8 HOW. 945, 540 12 L.
24 Ed. 1170, 1189 (1850).

1 **ERROR**

2 The Eighth Judicial District Court Clerk errors by assigning the habeas corpus hearing in
3 Department 23, without the Defendant's written consent. The habeas corpus hearing is in
4 direct contravention of Nev. R. Cr. P. Rule 9, section 6, "Any writ filed in a criminal case at
5 the district court level shall be assigned to the same department where the underlying
6 criminal case is filed." The Defendant demand the Eighth Judicial District Court Clerk to
7 uphold the Nev. R. Cr. P. Rule 9, section 6 by setting the habeas corpus hearing in
8 Department 1 with Eighth Judicial District Court Judge, BITA YEAGER, on July 26, 2022 at
9 9:00 A.M.

10 **TRANSFER TO PROBATE COMMISSIONER**

11 The Defense invokes the right to transfer and contest the "Discovery" provided by the
12 Prosecution pursuant to EDRC Rule 4.08 and EDCR Rule 4.17. The Defense request the
13 assigned probate judge to set the hearing date and a discovery schedule pursuant to EDCR
14 Rule 4.17.

15 **DISMISSAL**

16 The Defendant moves this case for dismissal pursuant to EDCR Rule 3.20(e) for the
17 Prosecution's case lacks merit and inability to provide sufficient evidence to support their
18 allegations. The defense request, in writing, for the Court Clerk to place a dismissal
19 hearing on calendar. This dismissal is with prejudice is pursuant to Monroe v. Columbia
20 Sunrise Hosp. & Med. Ctr., 123 Nev. 96, 103, 158 P.3d 1008, 1012 (2007)

21 **ASBESTOS CLAIM AND REMEDY**

22 For The Record, the Defendant's property is damaged by asbestos because of the STATE OF
23 NEVADA's negligence to allow BRIAN DAVILA LTD, LLC to possession the dwelling, commonly
24 known as, 608 HOLLAND AVENUE, LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, ZIPCODE: 89106, hereinafter
"Proerty", and contract with "BOSS PLUMBING" to excavate the Property's original
plumbing, from the early 1960's, on March 17, 2021, without having the Property inspecting
for asbestos and failing to have the Property properly prepared for a plumbing service
while RACHEL BLEY and children where currently inside the dwelling at the time the
contracted plumber was excavating and replacing the plumbing without any protective
gear. See indictment transcript and harassment complaint made by RACHEL BLEY. The
Defendant demands the STATE OF NEVADA have the Property inspected, cleaned and
cleared of asbestos before restoring the Defendant to the possession of the Property for
safety and welfare of the Defendant's family.

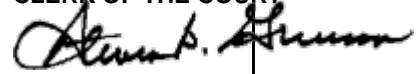
25 **HABEAS CORPUS**


