ORDER APPROVING SUBSTITUTION OF COUNSEL AND GRANTING MOTION TO TRANSMIT PRESENTENCE INVESTIGATION REPORT

Pursuant to the amended substitution of counsel filed on April 27, 2022, the clerk shall remove Larry K. Dunn and Karina K. Dunn as counsel of record for appellant. The district court clerk shall have 14 days from the date of this order to transmit to the clerk of this court a copy of the presentence investigation report in a sealed envelope. *See id.*; NRS 176.156(5) (providing that except for specific disclosures authorized by NRS 176.156(1)-(4), a presentence investigation report is "confidential and must not be made a part of any public record").
